Hundreds expected at Trust jobs fair

Leicestershire Partnership NHS Trust is hosting its third recruitment fair on 10 May showcasing jobs across our wide range of community and mental health services for all ages.

It follows on from the success of two earlier events in 2016, which were each attended by more than 700 job seekers.

At least 60 people gained jobs as a direct result of attending, and hundreds more learned more about the opportunities available at the Trust.

The next event takes place between 10am and 6pm on Wednesday May 10, 2017, at the Underwood Suite, Leicester Tigers' ground, Aylestone Road, Leicester, LE2 7TR.

We are repeating the jobs fair as the previous ones were highly successful. Those who attended appreciated the opportunity to discuss our vacancies face-to-face.

Sarah Willis, interim director of human resources and organisational development, said: "Please come along and meet us if you are looking for a job in the health service now, or in the near future. We have numerous nursing, clinical and non-clinical job opportunities and we will also be using the event to build our talent pool of the future. So register, come along, and have a chat with the team."

More than 20 teams will be taking part, including pharmacy, our in-house temporary agency (known as the bank), health visitors, mental health services for older people, our community hospitals, our stroke team, school nursing, and

our return to practice team. We are also looking to fill a number of administrative roles.

Visitors can explore opportunities in a range of new, developing and established roles in LPT's adult mental health services; including new rotational opportunities in its assertive outreach and acute inpatient services.

Other services exhibiting include acute, recovery and rehabilitation wards, the Trust's acclaimed specialist inpatient Huntington's Disease and community perinatal services and its ground-breaking street triage team. Roles range from registered and unregistered and therapy roles to new opportunities as trainee assistant practitioners, assistant psychologists and therapeutic liaison officers, with support offered for future professional development.

We are currently recruiting to roles at a range of different experience levels, so whether you are looking for an entry level role or are an experienced practitioner come along to find out what roles could be suitable for you.

During the recruitment event we will showcase some of the art work our patients have completed at our Recovery College and Involvement Centre.
