Outreach are nurses.



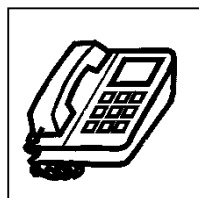
Outreach have been asked to help you when you become angry or upset.

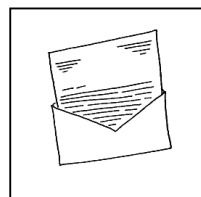

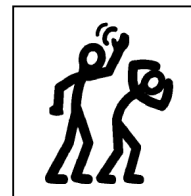
What happens when you get angry or upset?

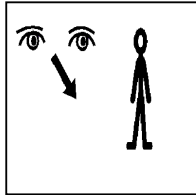

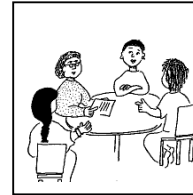
How will Outreach try to find out why you get angry or upset?



How will Outreach try to find out what helps you when you are angry or upset?



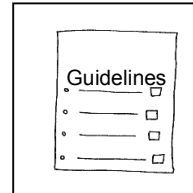
Outreach will see what you do during the day.



Outreach will help other people work with you.



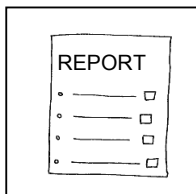

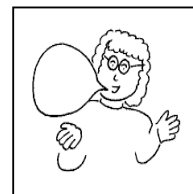
