### Request

#### REQUEST:

Please provide me with details of any patients who have died or have been injured after, or connected to, being restrained, either by hospital staff or police (or any other 'authority') since January 2005.

Please include all cases where a patient has sustained an injury after, or connected to, being restrained. Please include details of the injuries. Please include any cases where the patient has undergone any form of restraint, including physical, chemical or mechanical.

**PhysicalInterventionSENT** – This report outlines all incidents by cause of '*Injury during physical intervention*' from our old database Sentinel.

**PhysicalInterventionSENT1** – This report is similar to the above, but outlines all incidents by cause of '*Behaviour leading to physical intervention*'.

**Use Of Physical Restraint** – This report displays all cases when physical intervention has been necessary for any reason. Unfortunately, with this report already being 74 pages long it has not been possible to include the reason without adding the full incident description, which would make the report unmanageable. We will, however, be able to provide you with further details if you send in a further request re-focusing your request to specific incidents.

**Injured during physical restraint** – This is all cases when a patient has received an injury during any kind of physical restraint; incident details are included in this to assist you.
