

## Out of Area AMH Placement

### Request

When answering these questions, please provide figures for each of the financial years 2009/10, 2010/11, 2011/12, 2012/13 and 2013/14.

1. In each year, how many times were acute mental health service users placed by the Trust in private (so-called 'out-of-area') beds?
2. In each year, what did the Trust spend on such placements?
3. In each year, at the time figures were compiled for the annual report, how many acute mental health beds did the Trust have?

If five years' figures exceed the cost limit under the Act, you may provide figures for the most recent three years only.

### Our Response

1. Out-of-area beds were not used for acute adult mental health until 2013/14. The number of out-of-area patients in 2013/14 was 206.
