Referral criteria

- Children and young people from birth to age 16 (up to 19 years in statutory education) registered to GP practices in Leicester City, Leicestershire County and Rutland.
- Children and young people attending schools within Leicester, Leicestershire and Rutland if the physiotherapy therapy intervention needs to be delivered in the context of the curriculum.
- Children and young people with significant functional; independence; sensory; movement or perceptual difficulties that can be changed through physiotherapy therapy intervention.

We see children with:

- Developmental disorders or delays in their movement and gross motor skills
- Neurological deficit
- Acquired neurology
- Neuromuscular deficit
- Complex special needs that includes neurodevelopmental delay with complex physical disability equivalent to GMFSC III to V in CP

How to make a referral:
