We are connecting with staff through virtual events until we are able to resume frontline visits safely.</li> <li>Supported Mark Farmer of Healthwatch to launch the LPT People's Council on 16<sup>th</sup> September. Mark will chair the People's Council which is an advisory body for the Trust, it is made up of community representatives and individuals with a lived experience of receiving healthcare services from LPT.</li> <li>Launched the service user involvement induction process with our patient experience team on 16<sup>th</sup> October</li> <li>Attended service user recovery and care planning café event on 26<sup>th</sup> October.</li> </ul>
<p><b><u>Connecting for Quality improvement</u></b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Visited the new Beacon Unit where construction work is almost complete. This is a high quality environment which will support the recovery and wellbeing of our CAMHS inpatients.</li> <li>The 2020 CQC inspection of LPT has been postponed. The focus on improvement continues at the weekly Foundations for Great Patient Care meetings.</li> <li>LPT/NHFT Buddy meetings continue to support quality improvement in LPT and joint transformation projects in both trusts, this month we focused on IT, innovation and research.</li> <li>Attended the LLR suicide prevention conference</li> </ul>

<p><b><u>LPT's Charity : Raising Health</u></b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The LLR system has been granted £490,000 from NHS Charities Together (Phase 2) to support our communities to stay well and provide support during the pandemic recovery period. As part of Voluntary Action Leicester's future focus conference, LPT and UHL hosted the first engagement workshop. Our workshop had over 25 attendees from the LLR community who contributed ideas to the process and how to use this money effectively.</li> <li>• Chaired LPT's Charitable Funds Committee – please refer to the Highlight report which is later on the agenda</li> </ul>
