REQUEST:

- 1) Does the Trust have a specialist ADHD service for adults? If yes, can you give details please?
- 2) Once a patient is referred to Adult ADHD services, what's the target time for them to be seen for their first assessment?
- 3) Once a patient is referred to Adult ADHD services, what is the average time they are on a waiting list before their first assessment?
 - Can you provide the three longest periods of time a patient spent on the waiting list before their first assessment in 2019 and their gender please.
- 4) How many patients are currently on the Adult ADHD services waiting list?

OUR RESPONSE:

1. Yes. It is a clinic-based service that provides diagnosis, treatment and annual review for adults who are referred to the service and who live within Leicester, Leicestershire and Rutland. The service is comprises medical staff, nurses (all prescribers) and administrative staff.
2. 18 weeks
3. 28-32 weeks
 - 273 days (39 weeks) – Patient had cancelled 3 appointments offered to them before being seen for the first assessment. Male.
 - 245 days (35 weeks) – Patient had cancelled 5 appointments offered to them before being seen for the first assessment. Female.
 - 208 days (29 weeks) – Patient had cancelled 2 appointments offered to them before being seen for the first assessment. Female.
