OUR RESPONSE:

1. There is no set number of day patient places and numbers are dependent on need and acuity of current patients. There are usually up to 5 day patients.
2. We are commissioned to provide 14 beds.

5. The Trust has only had 4 admissions to Eating Disorder wards under the Mental Health Act in the last 5 years. There was 1 in the Under 18 demographic and 3 in the 19-50 demographic. 1 admission happened in September 2016, 2 in November 2016 and 1 in November 2017.
