- 1. I would like to know if your trust has a voting rights for service users policy? (If such a policy exists could you please send me a copy)
- 2. I would like to know if any inpatients were supported to vote in the 2017 general election (and if so how many?)

OUR RESPONSE: From our preliminary assessment, we estimate that compliance with your request would exceed the appropriate costs limit under section 12 of the Freedom of information Act 2000, currently £450, as we do not centrally record the information being requested at 2 above.
