Annual Self-Certification with NHS Provider Licence

Purpose of the report

The annual self-certification provides assurance to NHSE/I that NHS providers are compliant with the conditions of their NHS provider licence. On an annual basis, the licence requires NHS providers to self-certify that they have:

- a. effective systems to ensure compliance with the conditions of the NHS provider licence, NHS legislation and the duty to have regard to the NHS Constitution (condition G6);
- b. complied with governance arrangements (condition FT4).

Whilst NHS Trusts are not required to hold a provider licence, directions from the Secretary of State require NHSE/I to ensure that NHS trusts comply with conditions equivalent to those in the licence as it deems appropriate. NHS trusts are therefore legally subject to the equivalent of certain provider licence conditions.

Analysis of the issue

As a result of the CQC Inspection in November/December 2018 the Trust was issued with a Warning Notice in its findings that were published in February 2019.

In early May 2019 NHSI subsequently decided to move the Trust to Segment 3 under the NHSI Operating Framework. Segment Level 3 means Providers receive mandated support for significant concerns as there is an actual/suspected breach of the licence (or equivalent for NHS trusts).

Whilst the Trust has been reporting improvements in the well led agenda throughout the year, it has not had a revised SOF rating or well led inspection for the 2020/21 year. Therefore the Board is asked to authorise self-certification on the following basis:

Proposal

The evidence provided concludes that the two NHS Provider licence conditions G6 and F4 have not been met for the financial year 2020/21.

Decision Required

To self-certify non-compliance with the provider licence conditions G6 and FT4 for 2020/21.
