What is an Adult Autism Care Co-Ordinator and how can they help me?

The Adult Autism Care Co-Ordinator (AACCC) is a temporary role specifically to co-ordinate, integrate and deliver support to improve outcomes for autistic adults and their families across Leicester, Leicestershire and Rutland (LLR).

We can support with

- Co-ordinating and preparation for professional meetings and health appointments.
- Working with health services to increase understanding of the individual.
- Advocating for patients and their families in relation to health.
- Hospital discharge and transition back in to the community.
- Signposting to local support networks.
- Be a recognised point of contact for all involved with the individual.

How to access support.

To receive support from the Adult Autism Care Co-Ordinator you will need:-

- To be over 18.
- Have a diagnosis of Autism Only.
- A referral from a professional.
- A completed consent form.
