#### **LLR ICS Five-Year Joint Forward Plan**

### **Purpose of the report**

 The purpose of this report is to provide the Leicestershire Partnership Trust Board with the draft NHS Leicester, Leicestershire and Rutland Integrated Care Board (LLR ICB) 5-Year Joint Forward Plan (5JFP). Following development from across system partners the plan was approved by the LLR Integrated Care Board on 11th May 2023 to undergo a period of engagement, until the end of May 2023, and as such feedback from the LPT Board is being sought.
