Purpose	Meet and greet young people and their families when attending their appointments. Following appointments to support young people and families and support in completing friends and family questionnaire.

Hours	Flexible Monday to Friday or 7 days a week?

Reports to	Admin lead/reception staff/clinical leads and Family Services manager.
Benefits of this activity	Supports patients to develop their health, well-being and recovery.
	It can be a distressing time for some visitors when they arrive and not always sure where to go. This role would help with the improving the visitor experience.
Key tasks	 Welcome young people and their families into the building. Share information with young people and their families re support available by highlighting the QR codes/info on TV screens showing in reception area. Supporting the young people and family to complete the friends and family test following sessions. Update "you said we did " boards – to ensure that all posters displayed in waiting areas are up to date.
Person Specification and Requirements	 The following are mandatory requirements for this role: Applicants need to be over the age of 18. Some experience and knowledge of mental health, either personal or professional. Good communication skills, with the ability to empathise and show understanding. Enthusiasm for working with people and supporting them to improve their well-being and recovery Punctual and reliable Commitment to uphold trust core values and NHS policies
