Leicestershire Partnership NHS Trust supports people with a learning disability in Leicester, Leicestershire and Rutland.






We provide:

- The Agnes Unit:
 - this is a building for adults with learning disabilities and mental health needs

What we want to do



We want to move the short breaks service from the Grange and Gillivers bungalows to the Agnes Unit.




The Agnes Unit is only a 5-minute drive away from the Grange and Gillivers bungalows.

The same number of beds will still be available.



Short breaks will have their own private area at the Agnes Unit.

What the Agnes Unit offers



Each person staying at short breaks will have their own bathroom with a shower, sink and toilet.





Every pod (a small area of the unit) will have a shared living and dining room.



The same staff will be there to help you with your care.



We will make sure the pods are safe, welcoming and comfortable.

This includes:

- making sure it is safe
- putting in new equipment like hoists
- making it look nice



Why will the Agnes Unit be better?



It has doctors, nurses and other healthcare professionals.



If you need to stay here urgently we can try to make that happen.




It has a:

Having staff with different skills in one place will be better for you.


